Welcome to Manor View Farm

We are very fortunate to be involved in such a wonderful industry. To offer support for this industry, we encourage our team to get involved and give back to the industry we all benefit from.

We are very pleased that Kevin Clark is now a member of the Baltimore County Farm Bureau committee, Brian Mitchell has joined the board of the Maryland Nursery, Landscape, and Greenhouse Association (MNLGA) and Colin Jones has joined the board of the MD/DC/VA Chapter of the Landscape Contractors Association (LCA). Alan Jones continues to participate on the international board of the International Plant Propagators' Association (IPPS) and the board of trustees for the Horticultural Research Institute (HRI).

We are pleased to be an active member of the newly formed American Landscape Institute (ALI). This is a Baltimore County, MD group that is working with the Community College of Baltimore County, landscape contractors and growers to offer horticultural education through a European style apprenticeship program. Participants work four days a week and attend college classes one day a week. We are very excited that the first group of students started attending classes in September 2017. We continue to solicit additional employer participation and regularly attend high school career events to spread the word that a good career can be made in the horticultural industry.

While 2017 was full of challenges, we are grateful for the continuing recovery from the lengthy recession. The shortage of plant material will continue in 2018, especially with Boxwoods, large evergreens, and many varieties of caliper shade and ornamental trees. The stronger than expected 2017 fall season used up the material that many growers expected to have available for spring 2018. Many items will be a little smaller than we have been used to and the need for "creative substitution" will continue.

Our buyers and Sales Associates are second to none when it comes to sourcing material and we look forward to the challenge of assisting you with all your plant needs in 2018. We would however, ask that you show some consideration and understanding when we tell you your requests are somewhat unattainable based on the size and limited availability of some highly sought-after material.

We continue to rise to the challenge of "just in time" inventory and delivery demands. The time frame within which many of our customers demand a response to their plant requests seems to be getting shorter, as do the interesting and challenging requests for deliveries to unique jobsite locations. We regularly evaluate the delivery needs and demands of our customers and continue to add additional vehicle and trailer combinations to match those demands. Ask us about some of the more interesting and challenging jobsites our drivers have made deliveries to.

Pest and disease issues continue to add to the already long list of challenges this industry faces. Boxwood Blight continues to be one of the biggest concerns in the industry, as well as an increase in Scale and concerns from the spread of Emerald Ash Borer. One other major concern that is on our doorstep in parts of Pennsylvania is Spotted Lanternfly. I think we will be hearing a lot more about this potentially devastating pest in the near future.

The entire Manor View team appreciates and values your business and is ready to help you have a successful and profitable year. Please challenge us to help you to be more successful in 2018.

Delivery service is available using our own fleet of Manor View trucks. Delivery cost is based on a percentage of the cost of the order. All rates are subject to change. Customers are required to supply necessary labor and equipment to unload. Call our Delivery Coordinator for additional information.

Contractors and architects must accompany their customers to inspect plant material at the nursery. Please do not send your customers unaccompanied.

Children and pets are not allowed in the nursery.

We reserve the right to refuse loading material into inappropriate vehicles. This includes putting B&B material into cars, vans and SUV's.

Field Grown Material:

Manor View Farm has over 75 acres in field production. We currently have over 250 varieties of shade and flowering trees, evergreens, conifers and shrubs. Many of these are hard to find varieties in specimen sizes. We invite you to come and personally select your plants in the field or you may choose from pre-dug stock in our horticultural distribution center. For larger orders, we offer generous quantity discounts. We reserve the right to limit quantities of items in short supply.

Due to heavy demand, supplies are limited and we advise you to call for availability. If you have not visited us recently, plan to visit soon and see the quality of our plant material. VISITS BY APPOINTMENT ONLY!

We require a 25% non-refundable deposit on all tagged material to be dug. We ask plants be picked up within five (5) days of notification.

Tagging Material

Plant material will be held for five (5) business days only!

If tagged material is not picked up within five business days, the plants will be untagged and sold. Customers will not be called when their orders are untagged or sold. In the case of extenuating circumstances, a longer holding period can be arranged at our discretion at the time of tagging.

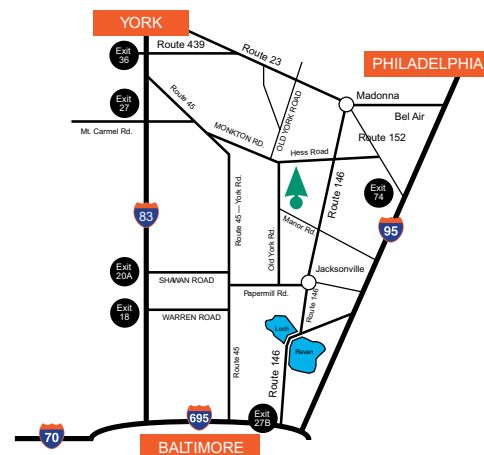
From WASHINGTON and points SOUTH OF BALTIMORE: Take 95 north to 695 west toward Towson to exit 27B (Route 146 north). Follow Route 146N over the reservoir bridge. At end of bridge is a fork and a traffic light. Take the left fork and stay on Route 146N. Follow Route 146N three (3) miles into town of Jacksonville. Turn left at the light at the intersection onto Paper Mill Road. Follow Paper Mill Road one (1) mile and turn right onto Old York Road. Follow Old York Road three (3) miles to stop sign. Turn left, go 100 feet, turn right into the driveway.

From points WEST OF BALTIMORE: Take Route 70 east to 695 north toward Towson. Take exit 27B (Route 146 north) and follow three (3) miles to reservoir bridge. At end of bridge is a fork and a traffic light. Take the left fork and stay on Route 146N. Follow Route 146N three (3) miles into town of Jacksonville. BEE Friendly Pollinators in the Landscape

What a great opportunity the landscape industry has to sell the benefits of a well designed landscape. It is well known that a diverse landscape benefits the environment vital to pollinators, birds and other wildlife as well as creating a great place for people to enjoy.

In recent years there has been a lot of discussion about the decline in bee and pollinating insect populations. While on-going research seems to indicate that there is no one single cause for this decline, there is evidence that changes in some of our industry practices will help increase the population.

In 2014 The Horticultural Research Institute established a "Horticultural Industry Bee & Pollinator Stewardship Initiative" and in 2015 funded four key projects in support of that initiative.

Another new initiative urges Americans to create 1 million pollinator gardens by the end of 2016. Landscape contractors, designers and landscape architects should be playing a major role in achieving this goal. We are after all, the original "Green Industry". Founded in June 2015, the National Pollinator Garden Network (NPNNG) launched a nationwide campaign - the Million Pollinator Garden Challenge. The challenge is to add one million additional pollinator gardens by the end of 2016.

Every habitat of every size counts, from window boxes, patio planters, small back yard gardens and landscaped gardens to farms, golf courses, school gardens, corporate and university campuses. All spaces where people live, work and play can, with the correct planting, offer essential food and shelter for pollinators.

"This effort focuses on creating habitat for pollinators. It's a critical undertaking because 80 percent of all plant species require pollination. This is not just an environmental nicety, it's an economic necessity" said Collin O'Mara, president and CEO of the National Wildlife Federation.

"Bearing in mind that the challenge urges gardens of all sizes, from window box or patio planters to large-scale landscapes, this is a great opportunity for our growers, garden retailers and landscape professionals who have or develop the expertise to design gardens that offer season-long pollen and nectar sources" said Craig Regelbrugge, senior vice president of Industry Advocacy & Research at AmericanHort.

Woody plants and perennials both play a role.

While there is more publicity about perennials that offer pollen and nectar sources, trees and shrubs play an equally important part of nature's critical life cycle. Many woody plants, as well as perennials, are food sources for the larval stage of our beloved butterflies and moths.

Native and non-native plants can be good for bee-friendly landscapes.

A recent study by the University of Illinois - Chicago found that neighborhoods with the highest floral diversity have the greatest abundance of bees and the greatest richness/diversity of bees. Yards with turf had fewer bees than yards with flower gardens.

As you are designing, be aware of the host plants necessary to attract many of these insects. Pollen and nectar plants only solve half of the problem. Without host plants, many insects will not successfully reproduce.

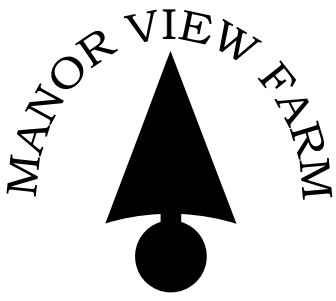
