At end of bridge is a fork and a traffic light. Take the left fork and stay on Route 146N. Follow Route 146N three (3) miles into town of Jacksonville. Turn left at the light onto Paper Mill Road. Follow Paper Mill Road one (1) mile and turn right onto Old York Road. Follow Old York Road three (3) miles to stop sign. Turn left, go 100 feet and turn right into the driveway.

**FROM POINTS WEST OF BALTIMORE:** Take Route 70 east to 695 north toward Towson to exit 27B (Route 146 north). Follow Route 146N over the reservoir bridge. At end of bridge is a fork and a traffic light. Take the left fork and stay on Route 146N. Follow Route 146N three (3) miles into town of Jacksonville. Turn left at the light onto Paper Mill Road.
